## Final Instructions

**Your Start Number and Start Time are in the attached Entry Sheet.**

Thank you for your entry to the 2010 Falcon Motor Club March Hare. The event will start at the Watling Street Café on the A5 by junction 9 of the M1, MR 166/085151 and finish at the Chequers Inn, Watling Street, Redbourn, Herts. AL3 7AD Map ref 166/111117. This is approximately 2.5 miles south east of the start continuing south of the M1 junction 9 on the A5183. A return route to the Truck Stop will be available at the finish. On arrival at the start please park with care, those with trailers should park as directed. Trailers may be left at the Watling Street café/Truck Stop for the day at your risk.

**YOUR VEHICAL MUST PASS SCRUTINEERING AND HAVE THE SCRUTINEERING CARD SIGNED BEFORE YOU CAN SIGN ON.**

**Drivers and passengers must sign on after scrutineering.** Please remember your club membership card and where applicable, MOT certificate and Competition licence. Also ensure that your car has a current road fund licence displayed.

**Also note that passengers MUST have a valid participating club membership card or on the day will have to join the ACTC passenger life member scheme for £1.00.**

**Competitors unable to show these documents may not be allowed to start**

Mr. John Newberry will be acting as the Club Steward for the event.

A route book and start numbers will be issued when you sign on. For those who like to follow progress on a map the OS sheets involved are 165 and 166.

Scrutineering will start at 7.30am. Cars will start at two minute intervals with car number one starting at 8.30am so please allow plenty of time. Attached is the entry list, please note your number and starting time.

**The Watling Street Café will be open for breakfast and refreshments.**

**THERE WILL BE NO CATERING** at the rest halt at Great Brickhill . A toilet will be available.

**Meals, Teas / Coffees and drinks will be available at the finish venue.**

**Meals DO NOT** have to be pre-booked.

**The menu can be viewed on line on the web site;- Chequers Redbourn**

Details of sections, tests, restarts and tyre pressures will be available at each venue where necessary. Drivers and passengers must not walk beyond the start line of any section/ test or holding area, infringement will incur a penalty equal to 12 points.

Competitors are requested not to take mud onto the road. Any competitor being passed by the course closing car will be deemed to have retired.

**Please be courteous and extremely quiet in built up areas you pass through as some are very sensitive to motor sport activity particularly in the Whitwell area (sections 1 & 3) and the Hawridge Lane / Hill Farm area (sections 12 & 13).**

**If you meet horse riders, pedestrians or dog walkers on any of the byways please stop and SWITCH OFF your engine until they have passed. This WILL NOT incur a penalty.**

**We are expecting to be observed by the Parish Council and the Highways Authority. We could well lose these sections next year if there are any complaints.**

Please remember that you **MUST SIGN THE DAMAGE DECLARATION and hand it in along with your competition numbers** at the end of the event. If you retire you must post the declaration to the secretary within 7 days.

To qualify for a finish certificate you must attempt each section.

Third in class subject to 8 starters.

Forth in class subject to 10 starters.

Results will be posted at the end of the event and prizes will be presented after the due 30 minutes protest period.
